- 4) Do you have opportunities to interact with the lost often?

- 2) Why do you think people who do know the truth of the Gospel might struggle with sharing what they know?
- 3) Do you have "tools" you use, things you've found over the years to help you kick off a conversation?
- 4) Do you often feel guilty over "failed" conversations with people who need Jesus?

## Evangelists

- 1) Would you say you are fairly eloquent in sharing Jesus with unbelievers?
- 2) Is it a foreign concept to you that others might struggle with evangelism?
- 3) Can you think of specific ways you communicate with unbelievers that might be helpful to share with those who are intimidated by evangelism?
